I thought it worthwhile to send out this mini-newsflash as it is very much looking like there will be no service running tonight after midnight, nor tomorrow (Monday) before 9am.

The latest official statement from FCC is here: <http://www.firstcapitalconnect.co.uk/plan-your-journey/major-disruption/>. Key phrases currently include:

- **In the interests of safety, Network Rail have advised us not to operate any trains on our network from Midnight on Sunday until it is safe to do so**, which is unlikely to be until after 0900 on Monday morning.
- Once trains resume, we will be operating a revised timetable with far fewer services and with extended journey times. It is possible that some lines may remain closed. **We advise you not to travel.**
